

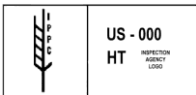


ISPM15 CERTIFICATION

WOOD PALLET HEAT TREATED CERTIFICATION

Declaration of Conformance

It is declared that all pallets sold with Part #'s (000115 & 65512) have a heat treat mill mark that certifies that those pallets were treated to 133 degree Fahrenheit for 30 minutes or longer. Chemicals are not used to heat treat wood at any stage of processing. This heat treat specification meets or exceeds the standard established by the USDA's Foreign Agricultural Service Animal and Plant Health Inspection Services (APHIS) and is ISPM 15 for shipment to any applicable accepting country. The certification facility is #04545 inspected by Lee Inspection # 800-508-6223, 2207 California Plaza, Suite #3, Bossier City, LA 7111.



What is a quality/treatment mark?

For both heat treatment (HT) and methyl bromide (MB) fumigation programs , the quality/treatment mark consists of the a) agency trademark which is the identifying symbol, logo or name of the accredited agency, b) the Facility Identification which is the WPM product manufacturer name, brand or assigned facility number, c) the HT or MB mark, d) the country code which is the two letter ISO country abbreviation, e) the IPPC Approved International Symbol for compliant wood packaging material and f) DUN when indication is used for dunnage.
